

## How do I pay my corporate income taxes?

### Canada Revenue Agency – Federal Tax

Method	Details	When is it considered paid?
Online banking	Add the CRA as a payee to make payments directly from your bank account.	Same or next business day.
One-time payment using CRA online services	Use a debit card with CRA's My Payment service. You cannot use a credit card.	Same or next business day.
Schedule one or more future payment(s) using CRA online services	Set up a pre-authorized debit (PAD) payment. Must be scheduled at least 5 business days in advance.	Same or next business day.
Counter (teller) service at a bank or credit union	Payment made directly from your bank account. Requires a remittance voucher.	Same day.
ATM of a bank or credit union.	Add the CRA as a payee before beginning. Payment made directly from your bank account.	Within 1-2 business days.
Canada Post retail location	Charges service fees. Requires customized QR code. Pay with debit card or cash.	Same day.
Third-party service providers	Charges service fees. Not endorsed by CRA. Credit card or money transfer.	Varies depending on the service provider.
Mail delivery (cheque)	Send a cheque (or a series of postdated cheques) with or without a paper return through the mail. Address to the <i>Receiver General for Canada</i> or the <i>Canada Revenue Agency</i> . May require a remittance voucher.	When delivered to the CRA, depends on mail delivery time.
Wire transfer at a foreign bank or credit union	Options and services available depend on the foreign bank or credit union. May require a remittance voucher.	Same or next business day.



## Government of Alberta – Provincial tax

Method	Details
Electronic payment through your financial institution	Go to “Pay Your Taxes Online.” Click on your financial institution and follow the instructions provided. Select “Alberta Finance” and the program that you are making a payment for. For example, “Alberta Finance – Corporate Income tax” located under “Provincial – Alberta.”
In person at your financial institution	Requires the original TRA remittance advice to be taken to the teller. You may request an original remittance advice through TRACS. Not all banks will accept this in person.
Credit Card or PayPal (PaySimply)	Uses PaySimply, a third-party service provider. They will send your payment and remittance details to TRA. Charges a fee. Takes approximately 3 business days to process. The TRA may charge penalties or interest if the payment does not reach them by the due dates.
Interac e-Transfer (PaySimply)	Uses PaySimply, a third-party service provider. They will send your payment and remittance details to TRA. Charges a fee. Takes approximately 1 business day to process. The TRA may charge penalties or interest if the payment does not reach them by the due dates.
Cash or Debit (PaySimply)	At any Canada Post location using PaySimply, a third-party service provider. Charges a fee. Takes approximately 3 business days to process. The TRA may charge penalties or interest if the payment does not reach them by the due dates.
Cheque or Money Order	Sent by mail or courier to TRA between 8:15 am – 4:30 pm MST weekdays, except statutory holidays. Do not send cash in the mail.



	<p>All cheques/money order must be payable to the <i>Government of Alberta</i>. On the back of your cheque/money order, note your Alberta Corporate Account Number and/or your Business Identification number (BIN), program name, and reporting period or tax year end of your payment. TRA considers the date they receive a payment to be the date used for interest calculation purposes, not the mailing date.</p>
Wire Transfer	Only available for non-residents.
